## **IN OFFICE PROGRAMS**

Central's IOP is a group therapy program tailored to empower adults with both behavioral health issues and substance use/abuse history to support their own recovery, cope more effectively, prevent relapse, and strengthen social relationships.

#### OASIS

OASIS is a partial hospital program tailored to help seniors with behavioral health and co-occurring challenges live as independently as possible within the community. Our staff utilizes treatment approaches to reduce symptoms and behaviors that are troublesome and distressing for both the individual and the caregiver.

#### **Outpatient Program**

Central's Outpatient Program assist individuals who struggle with mental health and substance abuse issues by providing services that focus on stabilizing behaviors. Central's therapists use various evidence based treatment approaches including Cognitive Behavioral therapy, Motivational Interviewing and Dialectical Behavior Therapy.

#### **Certified Peer Specialist**

Central's CPS's support individuals on the path of recovery by providing assistance, resources, and relatable personal experiences. The CPSs can aid consumers in creating a goal oriented recovery plan. establishing a network of natural supports, and preparing their return to the workforce & maintain employment with the aid of Central's Career Center.

#### **Clinical Wellness Recovery Team**

Central's CWRT program focuses on the health and wellness goals of individuals who have both a serious mental illness and a chronic physical health issue. The team consists of a Registered Nurse and/or a Behavioral Health Therapist who work collaboratively with individuals to coordinate treatment.

#### **Family Based Services**

Central's FBS program provides treatment to both children and their families that increases the caregivers' effectiveness and stabilizes the children's emotional and behavioral health

#### **Intensive Behavioral Health Services**

IBHS provides comprehensive treatment for children with emotional and behavioral needs and their families to become more functional in their natural settings and manage challenging behaviors more effectively.

#### **Transition to Independence Process**

Central's TIP Program supports young adults (ages 16 - 26) with emotional and/or behavioral health needs navigate the road towards independence. TIP facilitators assist young people pursue their goals regarding educational opportunities, living situations, employment and their career, community life functioning, and personal effectiveness & wellbeing.
